

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** The workshop provides all ground transportation, lodging, and meals beginning and ending in Tucson. The workshop has both field trips and classroom sessions. The classroom sessions are comprehensive and handouts will be provided. The workshop is limited to a maximum of 6 participants with a minimum of 3 participants required.

### TYPICAL SCHEDULE:

#### Day 1 - Arrival & Introductions

Prior to 6:00 pm Arrive and check-in at lodgings near Tucson International Airport (TUS).  
6:00 pm - 7:30 pm Meet other participants and instructor in lobby. Dinner at lodgings with introductions and overview.  
7:30 pm and after Remainder of evening free.

#### Days 2 through 5 - Field Trip & Classroom Sessions

6:00 am - 7:00 am Breakfast (general time frame depends on the time of year).  
7:00 am - 3:00 pm Field trip with stops at various habitats/locations.  
3:00 pm - 3:30 pm Return to lodgings and refresh.  
3:30 pm - 5:45 pm Classroom sessions on identification, vocalizations, and/or natural history.  
6:00 pm and after Dinner with remainder of evening free.

#### Day 6 - Departure

6:00 am - 11:00 am Breakfast at hotel.  
11:00 am Checkout time.

**LODGING:** All lodging is provided for the workshop. Typically, lodging for arrival and departure will be at the Double Tree Suites in Tucson, Arizona. The remainder of the nights will be at Battiste Bed, Breakfast & Birds. Rooms are assigned based on occupancy. A supplement of \$270 is required for single occupancy. If you prefer to share but do not have a roommate and a roommate cannot be assigned, the single occupancy supplement will apply.

**MEALS:** All meals are provided for during the workshop commencing with dinner on Thursday evening through breakfast on Tuesday morning. Meals include a full breakfast, a sack lunch, and dinner at a designated restaurant. The TYPICAL meal selections are as follows: breakfasts typically include scrambled eggs, sausage or ham, hot and cold cereals, bagels or toast, fresh fruits, yogurt, coffee, tea, milk, and juice; lunches are self-prepared after eating breakfast with the lunch makings provided typically including bread, a selection of meats, peanut butter, and other spreads, chips, fresh fruits, vegetables, and other sides; and, dinners at a designated restaurant and typically include a selection of 3 or 4 entrées (beef, chicken, pork, fish, and/or vegetarian) with a side dish, salad, and non-alcoholic drinks. A single desert selection may be available for the entire group.

**RESERVATIONS & CANCELLATIONS:** Cost of the workshop is \$1,395 per person (a supplement of \$270 is required for single occupancy), please call (520) 400-6176 to register. Payment in full is due no later than 120 days prior to the workshop start date. Unless the space is filled by another participant, cancellation fees are as follows: more than 120 days before the workshop permits a full refund minus a \$50 processing fee; between 120 and 90 days before the workshop forfeits 20% of the workshop fee; between 90 days and 60 days forfeits 50% of the workshop fee; and less than 60 days before the workshop forfeits 100% of the workshop fee.
